Contract withdrawal - cancellation conditions

1 The Contracting Parties are eligible to withdraw from the contract in cases established by the relevant legal regulations and/or VP. By contract withdrawal, this Contract becomes fully cancelled. The Contract withdrawal must be delivered in written notice signed by a person who is authorised to act and sign documents on behalf of the Contracting Party. The Contract withdrawal becomes effective on the date of delivery of the written notice of withdrawal from the Contract to the party to which it is intended.

2 In accordance with § 7 paragraph 1 of Act No. 102/2014 Coll on consumer protection in contracts concluded at distance, as amended, the Consumer is eligible to withdraw from the Contract without providing a reason within 14 days from the conclusion (signing) date of the Contract. The Participant is obliged to notify the Organizer about the withdrawal from the contract in written notice. For this purpose, the Participant can use the Form available on the Organizer's website.

3 In case the Participant cancells his participation in the Educational Event no later than 3 days before the relevant Educational Event, and does not request the Organizer for the possibility of his Substitute participating in the Educational Event, the Participant is obliged to pay the Organizer 100% of the Participation Fee as a Contractual Penalty (Cancellation Fee). The Organizer is entitled in duly justified cases and at its own discretion to waive the right to a contractual penalty (Cancellation Fee). If the Participant cancels his participation in the Educational Event 3 or more days before the relevant Educational Event and does not ask the Organizer for the possibility of his Substitute participating in the relevant Educational event, the Organizer will return 100% of the Participation Fee to the affected Participant.
